Read the assigned chapters of the Bible *before* the assigned date. Be ready to answer simple questions in class about what you read. Also, feel free to ask the pastor questions about what you read.

September 15: Luke 1-2; Matthew 1:18-2:23; John 1:1-18: The Foretelling and Birth of John the Baptist and Jesus

September 22: Luke 3-4; Matthew 3: John the Baptist; the Baptism and Temptation of Jesus; Jesus Begins His Ministry

September 29: Luke 5-6; John 3:1-21: Jesus Calls His Disciples, Heals many; Sermon on the Plain; Meeting with Nicodemus

October 6: Luke 7-8: Jesus Heals; Raises the Dead; John the Baptist in Prison

October 13: Luke 9-10: Jesus Sends out the Twelve; Feeds Five Thousand; Transfiguration; Sends out the Seventy-Two

October 20: Luke 11-12: The Lord's Prayer; Be Ready

October 27: Luke 13-14: Repent or Perish; Parables of the Great Banquet

November 3: Luke 15-16: Parable of the Lost Sheep, Lost Coin, and Prodigal Son; The Unjust Steward

November 10: Luke 17-18: Temptation to Sin; The Pharisee and the Tax Collector

November 17: Luke 19-20: Zacchaeus; The Triumphal Entry; Who is the Christ?

December 1: Luke 21-22: The Coming of the Son of Man; Jesus Betrayed and the Institution of the Lord's Supper

December 8: Luke 23-24; Isaiah 52:13-53:12: Christ's Death and Resurrection and Ascension

December 15: Acts 1-2: Ascension and Pentecost

January 5: Acts 3-4: The Word of the Lord Grows; Peter and John's Ministry

January 12: Acts 5-6: Ananias and Sapphira; Seven Chosen

January 19: Acts 7-8: Stephen's Speech and Martyrdom; Saul ravages the Church

January 26: Acts 9-10: Conversion of Saul: Gospel to the Gentiles

February 2: Acts 11-12: Peter Reports to the Church: James Killed; Peter Arrested and Escapes

February 9: Acts 13-14: Paul and Barnabas

February 16: Acts 15-16: The Council of Jerusalem; Philippian Jailer Converted

February 23: Acts 17-18: Thessalonica, Berea, Athens, Corinth, Antioch, and Ephesus

March 2: Acts 19-20: Paul in Ephesus

March 9: Acts 21-22: Paul in Jerusalem and His Arrest

March 23: Acts 23-24: Paul before Council, Felix the Governor, and his Imprisonment

March 30: Acts 25-26: Paul Appeals to Caesar; Before King Agrippa, Retells His Conversion

April 6: Acts 27-28: Paul Sent to Rome; Ship Wrecked on Malta; Paul Still in Prison in Rome, Preaching the Gospel

April 13: Romans 1-3: Gospel of Christ; Justification by Grace through Faith in Jesus Christ Alone apart from Works

April 20: Romans 4-6: Abraham Justified by Faith; Death in Adam, Life in Christ; Baptismal Regeneration

April 27: Galatians 1-3: Justified by Faith

May 4: Galatians 4-6: Heirs of the Promise, Christ Has Set Us Free; Walk by the Spirit

May 11: Ephesians 1-6: Salvation by Grace through Faith Alone; United in the Body of Christ (Last Day of Wednesday School)
